



DPLL All-Stars (Spring 2026)

Q&A

The Little League All-Star tournament is the most widely known youth sports tournament in the world. This season, on the baseball side, Dr. Phillips Little League will have opportunities for softball and baseball players leagues ages 8 to 16 to earn roster spots on an All-Star team!

The tournaments start at the District level, and teams must win their way to advance through the International Tournament. It all starts with the 8-9 All-Stars, which is a District-only tournament. The 8-10 All-Stars and 9-11 All-Stars offer tournaments which culminate at the State Level. And the Little League All-Stars, Intermediate All-Stars, Juniors All-Stars, and Seniors All-Stars all conclude at a World Series Tournament.

So here's everything you need to know about this season's All-Star tournaments...

Q: *How does my child declare for All-Stars?*

A: Any player wishing to declare themselves as an All-Star candidate must complete an on-line All-Star declaration. The declaration portal is found on our website (www.dpll.org) and will be available starting April 1st and will be open until April 17th @5 PM. Simply login to your account and select the "Register Now" button in the upper right-hand corner.

The All-Star declaration process will include:

- Selection of declared All-Star team (player can declare for two All-Star teams)
- Answering questions relating to the commitment of All-Stars
- Upload necessary residency documentation-if you do not live in our DPLL zone, your child will not be eligible for the All Star team
- Upload a copy of player's birth certificate
- The declaration does **not** guarantee an All-Star roster spot
- Eligible criteria for players are addressed in the Official Little League Rulebook under "Tournament Rules and Guidelines"



Q: Where will each All-Star tournament be played?

A: The locations of each tournament will be announced within the next couple of weeks. Each All-Star tournament will be hosted by one of the six leagues in our District: Apopka LL, Dr. Phillips LL, Ocoee LL, South Lake LL, Windermere LL, Winter Garden LL.

Q: How many All-Star teams will Dr. Phillips Little League have this season?

A: Up to Twelve (12). They are as follows:

8-9 Tournament of Champions (Baseball Only)

League Ages 8 & 9

District-only tournament

Probable Start date: May 26th

8-10 All-Stars (Baseball & Softball)

League Ages 8, 9, & 10

Earliest Start date: BB & SB - June 10th

9-11 All-Stars (Baseball & Softball) League Ages 9, 10 & 11

Earliest Start dates:

Baseball - June 10th

Softball – June 10th

Little League All-Stars (Baseball & Softball)

League Ages 11 & 12

Earliest Start dates:

Baseball - June 15th

Softball – June 8th

Intermediate All-Stars (Baseball Only)

League Ages 12 & 13

Earliest Start date: June 12th

Juniors All-Stars (Baseball & Softball)

League Ages 13 & 14 (league age 15's are not eligible)

Earliest Start dates:

Baseball - June 12th

Softball – June 10th

Senior All-Stars (Baseball & Softball)

League Ages 15 & 16

Earliest Start date:

Baseball - June 12th

Softball – June 10th



Q: How are the All-Star teams selected?

A: For the following teams, the manager and assistant coaches in certain divisions vote and select the top 9 players on an All-Star team:

8-9 All-Stars, 8-10 All-Stars, 9-11 All-Stars, Intermediate All-Stars, Juniors All-Stars

The All-Star manager then selects the remainder of the team's roster (1-3 additional players)

For Little League All-Stars, the players from each Majors team, the manager and assistant coaches from the Majors division select the top 9 players. The All-Star manager then selects the remainder of the team's roster (1-3 additional players)

For Seniors All-Stars, the league will conduct a try-out/evaluation of players league age 15 and 16 for both baseball and softball. The manager, assistant coaches, player agents and other independent evaluators will vote and select the top 9 players on each All-Star team.

The All-Star manager then selects the remainder for the team's roster (1-7 additional players)

Q: Is there a cost to declare for All-Stars?

No, there is not a cost to declare for an All-Star team. However, if your child is selected to an All-Star team, the fee is \$125, which covers the cost of uniforms (2 custom DPLL All-Star jerseys, pants, custom DPLL socks, belt and custom DPLL All-Star hat/visors)

Q: When will we find out who made DPLL's All-Star teams?

A: Most of the All-Star rosters will be announced on May 15th, via email blast and our league's Social Media accounts. The 8-9 roster will be announced prior to May 15th, and both Seniors All-Star rosters might be announced shortly after May 15th.
